- 1. In August, our Schools Committee hosted our fourth annual "All Class Picnic." This activity is sponsored by the Society in cooperation with Sheridan High School. The society pays all the expenses for this event, including park shelter rental fees.
- 2. The society incurs recurring expenses every other year for the hosting and registration of our website. The website includes the following listed items.

A listing of Sheridan High School faculty and staff from 1952 through spring of 2019. There is no other such historical compilation (within the school district or the previous Union school district). This work represents over forty hours of research of school annuals and commencement programs. We have published the list on our website.

Biographies of Sheridan High School faculty and staff. Fourteen have been completed, for all the principals of the high school from 1952 to the present. Five faculty members have been completed so far. They have published on our website.

Listings from the Sheridan High School Academic Wall of Fame (Valedictorians and Salutatorians) and the Athletic Wall of Fame. This is of particular importance as the "walls" have been removed from the high school and are being reformatted by the high school into a different presentation format. For now, our Society has the only listings currently available to the public. We have published these listings on our website.

A list of all school board members from 1952 to the current time. There is no other such listing available to the public. We have published the list on our website.

We have published the history of Sheridan High School and the history of Sheridan High School athletics on our website. We are now researching and writing the history of Sheridan High School music and theater for future publication.

Part X, line 4 (Continued)

We have completed and continue to update our compilation of our "Historical List City and Town Officials." We have also compiled and continue to update our "City of Sheridan – Historical Time Line." There are no other such historical compilations available to the public or from the city government. We have published both on our website.

The research for our parks history in the city of Sheridan has been completed and the narratives have been written. Our purpose was to provide historical narratives for signs to be posted in each park. Those narratives were provided to the South Suburban Park and Recreation District in February, 2018. The park district has already placed these histories on their website. In 2019, at the request of the park district we provided a historical narrative for the new Sheridan Square Park. The district intends to erect a historical sign with the narrative in the park. These histories would not be available to the public except for the work of our Society. We have also published these histories on our website.

- 3. We are planning publishing additional books. In 2004 we published our first book "The History of the Sheridan Police Department." In 2005 we published our second book "The History of the Sheridan Fire Department." We are continuing our work on identifying early ownership of land within the city. This will be the basis of another book on early homesteaders in the City of Sheridan. We have digitized maps and aerial photos of the city.
- 4. We are in the process of republishing "The History of Sheridan Colorado." This book was originally written and published in 1957 by our legacy organization. The book is currently out of print.
- 5. Planning and research is underway for our fifth historical marker. This marker is for the north gate of historic Fort Logan. This fort served the military from 1887 to 1960. Dwight D. Eisenhower was assigned and living on this military post from 1924 1925.
- 6. We are continuing research and planning for an historical museum for the city. We continue to accumulate historical documents, histories, and artifacts which need a permanent home.
