Record of Proceedings September 30, 1993

Trustees present: Bonita Hutcheson, Earl McCoy, Cliff Mueller; Others present: Bill Carter.

President Bonita Hutcheson announced that Robert Sitler resigned as a member of the Board of Trustees because of health limitations.

Roll Call The President called the meeting to order at 7:45 p.m.; the roll call of Trustees and visitors followed.

Approval of July 22 minutes Cliff Mueller moved, and Bonita Hutcheson seconded, approval of the minutes of the last meeting, on July 22. The motion was approved.

Reports

Treasurer Cliff Mueller reported for the Treasurer that, as of August 31, the savings account had \$2,272.34, and there was \$59.74 in the draft balance. Bonnie Hutcheson stated that she is submitting the bill for the corporate seal in the amount of \$19.95.

Cliff Mueller spoke with the Jaycees, who offered to assist the Historical Society. A hay wagon was picked up in Aurora as part of the collection of historic items. The owner, a Mr. Golden, donated the wagon and Mueller gave him a receipt for a \$100 contribution.

Old business

Richard Lynch checked fence prices to enclose the Historical Society area on the school property. Rental fences are too expensive; he lopes to get one installed for \$1600.

New business Cliff Mueller talked about getting historic recognition for the proposed development and the buildings to be moved. Earl McCoy suggested that he contact Holly Wilson at the Colorado Historical Society for information about eligibility for the State Register of Historic Properties.

For next year's Sheridan booklet, President Hutcheson said they will write about personalities past and present involved with Sheridan.

Adjournment The president adjourned the meeting at 8:50 p.m. The next meeting will be on October 28; in the November the meeting will be on November 18.
