Record of Proceedings
February 22, 1999

The Chairman, Cliff Mueller, called the meeting to order at the new city hall 4101 S Federal, at 8:16 p.m. Present for the roll call: Cliff Mueller, Chuck West, Bonita Hutcheson, and Earl McCoy.

The minutes of January 21, 1998 were approved as presented.

The Treasurer, Chuck West, reported \$8,350.04 in the savings and \$38.85 in the checking account.

- Bonita Hutcheson presented a bill for \$7.10 for copies and mailing of the minutes, and re-submitted the bill from last month for \$7.31, a total of \$14.41.
