Record of Proceedings  
April 23, 2001

A meeting of the Board was called to order by Chairman Cliff Mueller at 7:30 p.m.  
Present for the meeting Cliff Mueller, Bonita Hutcheson, Charles West, Bill Carter, Eddie Kanoza, and Rowena Yarbrough

Rowena showed a photo of the fire department with one of the trucks. All the firemen were identified on the back, although those present knew many. She will take it in and get it copied for the Historical Society.

The minutes of March 26, 2001 were approved as presented.

The list of Police Chiefs was updated with new information.

The treasurer, Charles West reported that there is \$11,085.34 in the savings with the deposit of funds from the last meeting, and \$62.91 in the checking. A bill from Bonita Hutcheson for printing and mailing of \$8.82 was approved for payment, since the treasurer did not have checks with him it was deferred to the next meeting. Jean Moore paid dues for three years.

The plats have not been purchased yet. Many plats were found and described in the plat book at the county, fifty or sixty. They will be organized and reviewed to be sure they relate to Sheridan. A motion was made by Bill Carter, that all plats are to be purchased and authorize the expenditure. Seconded by Chuck West and carried.

The IRS report was discussed. A meeting was set for May 14<sup>th</sup> at 1 p.m. to work on it.

The Tommie King Lumber Yard used to be where C & M Iron is now. It was destroyed in a fire.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 8:21 p.m.
