This meeting was called to bring from the table item 7 in the minutes of May 23, 2011. Present for the meeting were Chairman Cliff Mueller, Treasurer Roger Rowland, and Secretary Bonita Hutcheson.

- “(7. Old business: Bids were opened for the plaque to be placed for Petersburg, now River Pointe. Bid letters were sent to:
- a. Farmer’s Trophies, which was return undeliverable.
 - b. Erie Landmark Co, for an aluminum sign with only lettering 20” x 14” \$705.00 and \$45.00 shipping.
 - c. Norman’ Memorials, 24” wide x 20” high” with a post for mounting, one photo in bronze, \$2,875.00 in aluminum, \$2,229.00, we pick up.
 - d. Alpine Trophies, bid was \$1,830.90 plus shipping. 20” x 24” bronze.)”

Cliff Mueller showed a bronze plaque from Alpine Trophies, which was very heavy and beautifully made. He said that the owner Ken was very helpful.

A motion was made to accept the bid from Alpine Trophies for a 24” x 20” bronze plaque with the wording only, for \$1,820.90 plus shipping. This motion carried.

Cliff had also looked into the cost of a post for the sign, something that could be read easily from the bike path. He had a verbal estimate from Weld-Wright in Sheridan to make the post with a frame for the plaque. A motion was made to authorize him to order a post not to exceed \$500.00. Motion carried.

Cliff also had contacted Miller Weingarten, about placement of the plaque and their donation toward the cost, discussed at an earlier date. They wanted a map drawing of the site where the plaque would be situated. Cliff will take care of this map.

With no further business the meeting was adjourned.

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
