



**Sheridan Historical Society
Trustee Meeting
Monday at 7:00 PM
November 23, 2015**

The meeting was called to order by Cliff Mueller in the Community Room, Sheridan City Hall, 4101 S. Boulevard at 6:50 pm.

Board members present Cliff Mueller, Bill Carter, Roger Rowland, Bonita Hutcheson, Chuck West, and Don Ezell. There were no guests at the meeting.

A motion was made by Roger, second by Don to approve the September 28, 2015 minutes. The motion was approved.

Roger gave the Treasurer's report. There was a total balance in the accounts of \$7,823.49, see exhibit A. A motion was made by Chuck, second by Cliff, to accept the report. The motion was approved. See exhibit A. Annual dues totaling \$40.00 were paid by Bill Carter, Ron & Mary Carter, Andrew Padbury, and Barbara Padbury.

Correspondence was received from Andrew Padbury.

There was discussion on the display case. Don had mentioned there may be items that may possible to display from the school district warehouse. Don will arrange with the district to go and look.

A printed report was given by the Schools Committee, exhibit C. A verbal report was also given.

Some students had assisted in gathering names from the Academic Wall of Fame in the high school. Thank you letters from the Historical Society have been prepared for the students. The letters were signed by Cliff and Bonita. Roger will send them to the high school principal for delivery to the students.

Updates have been made to the society website up Homecoming Royalty, exhibit D and the Academic Wall of Fame, exhibit E. All of the high school principals are now listed on the website.

Roger reported the high gym had been damaged in a storm this past spring. The floor is in the process of being replaced. The gym will be reopened in January.

Roger reported the obituaries had also been updated on society website.

There was discussion about the shooting that occurred this past week near the high school and recreation center. One of the suspects was captured in the school district bus garage. There was a lock down at both the high school and Northgate school

(grades 3 – 8). All of the students and staff members were safe. The students from Northgate and the high school were bused off site to be reunited with their parents. There was an on going search for two other suspects.

There was a discussion about the wording on the historical signs for the parks. Cliff had spoken with Arlene. She did not have much information. Cliff will follow up with Randy Mourning to try and get more information. Information is need on Bobcat, Wildcat, Persinger, and Veterans Parks. We already have information on Barnes, Chase, Nesbitt, and Sheridan Community Parks.
