Trustee Meeting
Tuesday at 5:30 PM
July 28, 2026**

Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order by Dallas in the “River Point” community room in the Sheridan Municipal Center at 4101 S. Federal Boulevard at 5:30 pm.

The following board members were present: Dallas Hall, Annette Ivey, Andrew Rogge, and Roger Rowland. Board member Ernie Camacho was excused from the meeting. There were no guests

A motion was made by Andrew and seconded by Dallas to approve the minutes of May 26, 2026. The motion was approved.

Treasurer’s Report

The current balance is \$4,954.31. Roger reported the Secretary of State Annual filing has been completed. Roger requested reimbursement of the state \$25.00 filing fee and police department supplement binding materials of \$76.05. A motion was made by Andrew and seconded by Annette to accept the report and approve the reimbursements.. The motion passed. Dallas paid his annual dues.

Correspondence

There was no correspondence.

Old Business

The “History of the Sheridan Police Department 2026 Supplement” final print was completed. Roger has presented it to the city council. Final copies were given to the board.

A website update has been completed for Dr. Ken Reiter former Sheridan High School Principal and Superintendent. Dr. Reiter passed away on November 3, 2025.

The police department will be holding their National Night Out event on Tuesday, August 4, 2026. The society has participated the last several years and will participate again this year. Ernie will assist Roger with the canopy and table set up.

A Memorandum of Understanding for the proposed “history room” in the school district administration area (in the old high school east wing) has been reviewed by the school board in their recent work session.

A Freedom of Information request has been completed and submitted to the city for records of Monaghan’s. The “address files” (building and zoning) have been received. A partial list of licenses has been provided dating back to 1998. The city council minutes review for licenses remains to be completed for prior years.

New Business

Roger presented a draft of the “Sheridan Celebrates Booklet” by the Historical Society for the 2026 event. The booklet includes a bio on the parade grand marshal Ken Chavez (School Resource Officer), obits or Linda Jenner (Sheridan High School teacher for 30 years) and Jack VanArsdol (Sheridan Police Chief from 1986 through 1993, and the main article is the history of Alice Terry Elementary School. The members the City Council, School Board, and South Suburban Board are included along with a list of city employees. This will be the first Celebrates booklet we have printed since 2015.

The new principal at Alice Terry Elementary is Meagan Mullens-Williams and the new principal for Soar Academy is Chris Garcia.

Annette spoke about the new Englewood History Exhibit and their civic center. The exhibit was put together by the Englewood Historic Preservation Society and is about Englewood Schools history.

Annette presented pictures she had collected from Logantown (the area around Monaghan’s) including the railroad station, Monaghan’s Fort Logan Grocery, and the original Fort Logan Elementary School (before any of the additions). Annette asked about arrangements to view the proposed history room in the school district administration building. Roger said he would contact Polly Plancarte as the school district.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:01 pm.
